



Volunteer Opportunities With Worcester County 4-H

Worcester County 4-H provides volunteer opportunities to work with students and children. 4-H activities are developed and presented in Worcester County Schools for in-school, after-school and summer **school programs**. There are 4-H **clubs** in the county that do a variety of projects. We also go to **community events** where we present 4-H booths and programs. All of these opportunities allow for interactive, hands-on programs for youth 8 through 18 years of age.

For **school programs**, we are looking for volunteers who can eventually go into the schools and teach the program themselves. This can be a long term commitment of a school year, or a short term, one time helping opportunity. Volunteers do need to do all the necessary paperwork required by 4-H. We will provide the on and off-site trainings needed.

For **clubs**, we need leaders and co-leaders. This may be as short as 6 weeks, or as long as a year. Again, volunteers must complete 4-H paperwork and attend trainings.

For **community events**, we need just very short term volunteers, to help man booths. If you would like to learn how to present a certain program, it can become a long time volunteer opportunity, where you can present the program at different events. For this, you would need training and paperwork completed.

Afterschool-science programs, robotics

Summer school- environmental programs

Community events- environmental programs, safety programs, Worcester County Fair

4-H clubs have a variety of projects, including crafts, horses, nature, livestock, community service, robotics and health.

4-H provides a wonderful opportunity to present hands-on fun programs!

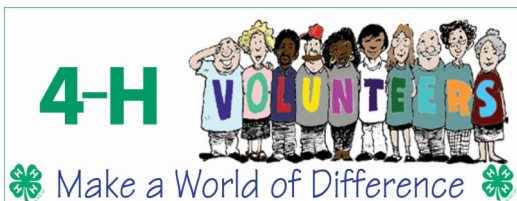
